



Awaiting your documents or tax disc from DVLA?

We are processing applications as normal. Due to the difficult weather conditions Royal Mail have advised us of delays. Please make allowances for these delays into and from DVLA.

Taxing your vehicle

If you're due to tax your vehicle from 1st January 2011 you can still use our [online](#) or telephone service. If you apply to tax your vehicle on or before the 31st December 2010 you'll have up until the 11th January 2011 before you need to display your new disc (this is due to the Christmas and New Year Bank Holidays). You should continue to display your old disc until the new one arrives. If you live in an area which has been affected by mail disruptions due to severe weather, you may wish to get your tax disc from your nearest Post Office® branch that issues tax discs.

Driving Licences

You can also apply for your first provisional driving licence, renew, update, exchange or replace your driving licence online.
